



**RESOLUTION NO. 54
Series of 2022**

WHEREAS, the President of the Philippines issued Proclamation no. 1267 Declaring a State of Calamity in Regions IV-B, VI, VII, VIII, X and XIII ;

WHEREAS, the declaration of the State of Calamity will hasten the rescue, relief, and rehabilitation efforts of the Government and private sector, including any international humanitarian assistance;

WHEREAS, this declaration will among others effectively control the prices of basic goods and commodities in the affected areas, and afford the National Government, as well as local government units (LGUs), ample latitude to utilize appropriate funds for the rescue, recovery, relief, and rehabilitation of, and the continuation of basic services to, affected populations, in accordance with law;

WHEREAS, all departments and other concerned government agencies are hereby directed to implement and execute rescue, recovery, relief, and rehabilitation work in accordance with pertinent operational plans and directives;

WHEREAS, the Secretary of the Department of Agriculture issued Memorandum dated December 28, 2021, the subject of which is 2022 Marching Orders and Way Forward, Major Burning Issues, and Rehabilitation and Recovery Plan for Typhoon Odette-Affected Regions, more than ensuring national food security in these difficult times, but more purposely ensuring performance of the agriculture sector to grow and our farmers and fisherfolks to prosper;

WHEREAS, part of that Memorandum is to preposition seeds for rice, corn, high-value crops, drugs and biologics for livestock and poultry for post disaster responses;

WHEREAS, Republic Act 9184 and its Revised Implementing Rules and Regulation allows Negotiated Procurement during Emergency Cases when time is of the essence arising from natural or man-made calamities;

WHEREAS, under Negotiated Procurement through emergency cases the BAC shall undertake the Negotiation with the supplier with technical, legal and financial capability to deliver the goods to be procured;

WHEREAS, a Purchase Request for **Supply and Delivery of Vegetable Seeds (9 in 1 pack)** with **ABC of Php 1,697,000.00** will be undertaken for the purpose of this procurement;





WHEREAS, the Bids and Awards Committee (BAC) Negotiated the Procurement for the Supply and Delivery of Vegetable Seeds (9 in 1 pack) to **ILOILO NEW AGRI-INDUSTRIAL MKTG. & GEN. SERVICES** who has the technical, financial capability to deliver the items to be procured;

WHEREAS, upon careful examination, validation and verification of all the eligibility, technical and financial requirements submitted by **ILOILO NEW AGRI-INDUSTRIAL MKTG. & GEN. SERVICES** it was found out that the supplier is technically and financially capable to undertake and fulfill the delivery of the items to be procured;

NOW, THEREFORE, we the members of the Bids and Awards Committee,(BAC) hereby **RESOLVE** as it is hereby **RESOLVED**:






