**GASS NP (EMERGENCY CASES)**  
**Under Proclamation no. 1267**

**RESOLUTION NO. 66**  
**Series of 2022**

**WHEREAS**, the President of the Philippines issued Proclamation no. 1267 Declaring a State of Calamity in Regions IV-B, VI, VII, VIII, X and XIII ;

**WHEREAS**, the declaration of the State of Calamity will hasten the rescue, relief, and rehabilitation efforts of the Government and private sector, including any international humanitarian assistance;

**WHEREAS**, this declaration will among others effectively control the prices of basic goods and commodities in the affected areas, and afford the National Government, as well as local government units (LGUs), ample latitude to utilize appropriate funds for the rescue, recovery, relief, and rehabilitation of, and the continuation of basic services to, affected populations, in accordance with law;

**WHEREAS**, all departments and other concerned government agencies are hereby directed to implement and execute rescue, recovery, relief, and rehabilitation work in accordance with pertinent operational plans and directives;

**WHEREAS**, the Secretary of the Department of Agriculture issued Memorandum dated December 28, 2021, the subject of which is 2022 Marching Orders and Way Forward, Major Burning Issues, and Rehabilitation and Recovery Plan for Typhoon Odette-Affected Regions, more than ensuring national food security in these difficult times, but more purposely ensuring performance of the agriculture sector to grow and our farmers and fisherfolks to prosper;

**WHEREAS**, part of that Memorandum is to preposition seeds for rice, corn, high-value crops, drugs and biologics for livestock and poultry for post disaster responses;

**WHEREAS**, Republic Act 9184 and its Revised Implementing Rules and Regulation allows Negotiated Procurement during Emergency Cases when time is of the essence arising from natural or man-made calamities;

**WHEREAS**, on the basis of 2021 Western Visayas Planting Report there were seventeen thousand (17,00) hectares more or less were planted early for wet season for the period of March 16 to May 31, 2021;

**WHEREAS**, there is already absence of "material time element" when time is of the essence from the time of the issuance of Marching Orders, Way Forward, Major Burning Issues, and Rehabilitation and Recovery Plan for Typhoon Odette-Affected Regions, dated December 28, 2021 and release/receipt of relative issuances to support the determination of appropriate hybrid varieties for Western Visayas;





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**WHEREAS**, to actually pre-position rice seeds for post disaster rehabilitation and to recover production loss for regions affected by Typhoon Odette thus curtailing the widespread rice insufficiency caused by calamity the procurement process has to be shortened through most appropriate mode favorable to the government and national economy;

**WHEREAS**, under Negotiated Procurement through emergency cases the BAC shall undertake the Negotiation with the supplier with technical, legal and financial capability to deliver the goods to be procured;

**WHEREAS**, a Purchase Request for **Supply and Delivery of 4,448 bags of Various NSIC Approved Hybrid Rice Seeds @ 15 kgs./bag with ABC of Php 22,435,000.00** will be undertaken for the purpose of this procurement;

**WHEREAS**, the Bids and Awards Committee (BAC) Negotiated the Procurement for the **Supply and Delivery of 4,448 bags of Various NSIC Approved Hybrid Rice Seeds @ 15 kgs./bag** to suppliers; distributors; manufactures who has the technical, financial capability to deliver the items to be procured;

**WHEREAS**, the Bids and Awards Committee (BAC) Negotiated the Procurement for the **Supply and Delivery of Various NSIC Approved Hybrid Rice Seeds @15 kg/bag with ABC of Php 22,435,000.00 to MODEL AGRO SALES** who has the technical, financial capability to deliver the items to be procured with the following varieties: NSIC Rc 314H; NSIC Rc 540H; NSIC Rc 456H and NSIC Rc 322H;

**WHEREAS**, upon careful examination, validation and verification of all the eligibility, technical and financial requirements submitted by **MODEL AGRO SALES** it was found out that the supplier is technically and financially capable to undertake and fulfill the delivery of the items to be procured;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, we the members of the Bids and Awards Committee,(BAC) hereby **RESOLVE** as it is hereby **RESOLVED**:


- a. To recommend the award of the contract through Negotiated Procurement (Emergency Cases under Proclamation No. 1267 to **MODEL AGRO SALES** to undertake and fulfill the **Supply and Delivery of Various NSIC Approved Hybrid Rice Seeds @15 kg/bag** in the amount of **Php 22,240,000.00**;
- b. To recommend for the **APPROVAL** by the Regional Executive Director of DA RFO 6 of these foregoing findings.






