NOTICE FOR NEGOTIATED PROCUREMENT

The **Department of Agriculture -Western Visayas** invites all suppliers to participate in the **NEGOTIATION** for the **Procurement of Supply and Delivery of Six (6) Units Corn Mill** with the following specifications:

Six (6) Units Corn Mill

1. Brand New
2. Compact Type
3. Input capacity: 350 kg/hr (minimum)
4. Engine (Prime Mover):
Brand New
12 Hp (minimum)
Water-cooled diesel engine
Maximum power developed: 80% of the rated maximum power
Continuous power developed: 80% of the rated maximum power
Specific Fuel consumption: 350 g/kW-hr (maximum)
5. With set of manufacturer's standard tools required for maintenance
6. Shall conform to PAES 251:2021, Corn Mill
7. Provision of ear muffs or any ear protective device is mandated when the noise level exceeds the minimum requirement
8. With steel ladder minimum of 3 steps

Additional Requirements:

1. With AMTEC Test Result
Coupled - Corn Mill and Electric Motor/Engine
Individual - Engine
2. With brochure (Engine and Corn Mill)
3. With instruction/operations manual for both Corn Mill and Engine (to be submitted upon delivery).
4. With reflectorized DA Western Visayas logo (minimum of 6" diameter)
5. Warranty Period: One (1) year from the date of acceptance of the recipient/beneficiary
6. The brand offered for the engine must be available in the local market for, at least thirty (30) years.
7. Service Center must conform to PAES 138:2004 and should have an available spareparts and technician within Region 6.
8. Supplier should have an authorized dealership from manufacturer/distributor of Corn Mill (applicable for dealers only).
9. Must have a valid Certificate of Accreditation from National Agricultural and Fisheries Machinery Assemblers, Manufacturers, Importers, Distributors and Dealers Accreditation and Classification (NAMDAC) Board.
10. Must have a valid Permit to Operate (PTO).
11. Must have a valid Certificate of Conformity (CC) for the Engine offered.

ABC: Two Million Eight Hundred Eighty Thousand Pesos (Php 2,880,000.00).

Delivery of the Goods is required **within 60 calendar days** from receipt of Notice to Commence and to be delivered in **DA-ROS Sigma, Capiz (3 Units); DA-ROS La Granja, La Carlota, Negros Occidental (2 Units) and DA WESVIARC, Brgy. Buntatala, Jaro, Iloilo City (1 Unit).**



Interested Suppliers must submit requirements for accreditation in order to participate in the negotiation for said procurement.

Deadline for submission of documents for accreditation and offer **is on or before 1:00 P.M., April 24, 2023** at the **RCPC Library, DA-WESVIARC Compound, Brgy Buntatala, Jaro, Iloilo City**.

REQUIREMENTS FOR ACCREDITATION

“Class A Documents”

1. **Platinum PhilGEPS** Certificate of Registration and Membership (including annexes). In case of joint venture, each partner shall submit their respective PhilGEPS Certificate of Registration;

Technical Documents

2. **Statement of all its On-going Government and Private Contracts**, including contracts awarded but not yet started if any whether similar or not similar in nature and complexity to the contract to be bid.
3. **Statement of the Bidder’s Single Largest Completed Contract (SLCC)** covering the period 2020-2022 that is similar to the contract to be bid;

The **two** statement shall include, for each contract, the following:

- 3.1) Name of Contract
- 3.2) Date of the Contract
- 3.3) Contract Duration
- 3.4) Owner’s Name and Address
- 3.5) Kind of Goods
- 3.6) Date of Delivery
- 3.7) The statements
 - 3.7.1 On-going Contracts – amount of contracts and value of outstanding contracts supported by:
 - Contract/PO
 - Notice of Award
 - Notice to Proceed issued by the owner
 - Certificate of Accomplishment/Delivery Receipt signed by the owner or authorized representative (if applicable)
 - 3.7.2 SLCC
 - completed contract and whose value adjusted to current prices using the Philippine Statistics Authority (PSA) consumer price indices, must be, at least, fifty percent (50%) of the ABC. However, in the case Expendable supplies, said SLCC must be at least twenty-five (25%) of the ABC.
 - supported by contract/PO, end-user’s inspection and/or acceptance report or official receipt(s) or sales invoice issued for the contract, which shall be attached to the statement.



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4. Latest income and business tax returns per Revenue Regulations 3-2005;
 - a) If the filing of the business and income tax returns is joint as in BIR Form No. 1701, the combined tax returns must be for the period ending December 31, 2021.
 - b) If the filing is not joint as in BIR Form No. 1702, the income tax return must be for the period ending December 31, 2021 and the business tax return must cover the 4th quarter of 2022 or December 31, 2022.

Class “B” Documents

1. If applicable, valid Joint Venture Agreement (JVA) shall be submitted.
2. **Sworn Statement** by the prospective bidder or its duly authorized representative in the form prescribed by the GPPB as to the following:
 - a.) It is not “blacklisted” or barred from bidding by the GOP or any of its agencies, offices, corporations or LGUs, including foreign government/foreign or international financing institution whose blacklisting rules have been recognized by the GPPB;
 - b.) Sworn affidavit of the bidder that it is not related to the HOPE, members of the BAC, the TWG, BAC Secretariat, the head of the Project Management Office or end-user unit by consanguinity or affinity up to the third civil degree.
