- Not less than 230 kg in weight
- Not less than 2 years but not more than 5 years of age
- No physical defects primarily for draft and secondary for breeding purposes
- With nose ring affixed more than 1 month prior to delivery
- Dewormed prior to delivery with fecalysis result (none to mild), vaccinated against Hemorrhagic Septicemia one month prior to delivery with Veterinary Health Certificate issued by a licensed veterinarian
- With Credentials
- With permanently labelled eartags “DA-SAAD 2023”
- Other requisites
 1. Sourced from BAI-Licensed Livestock Enterprise
 2. BAI Registered Livestock Transport Carrier
 3. AWA-Registered Facility
 4. To be replaced within 10 days after delivery in case of
 - a. Mortality due to stress
 - b. Stress related disease and condition

Deadline for submission of documents for accreditation and of fer is on or before 10:00 A.M. (June 23, 2023) and must be duly received by the BAC Secretariat.

REQUIREMENTS FOR ACCREDITATION

“Class A Documents”

1. Registration certificate from the Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC) - Department of Trade & Industry (DTI) for Sole Proprietorship or Cooperative Development Authority (CDA) for cooperatives.
2. Valid and current Mayor’s permit issued by the city or municipality where the principal place of business of the prospective bidder is located – 2023

Technical Documents

1. Statement of all its on-going and completed government and private contracts within the period stated in the Invitation to Bid, including contracts awarded but not yet started if any whether similar or not similar in nature and complexity to the contract to be bid (2020 - present).

The statement shall include for each contract the following items:

- 3.1) name of contract
 - 3.2) date and status of contract
 - 3.3) kinds of goods
 - 3.4) amount of contract and value of outstanding of contracts
 - 3.5) date of delivery; and
 - 3.6) Contract or Purchase Order and end user’s acceptance or official receipt(s) issued for the Contract, if completed
2. A single completed contract covering the period 2020-present that is similar to the contract to be bid and whose value adjusted to current prices using the National Statistics Office (NSO) consumer price indices must be at least fifty percent (50%) of the ABC. However, in the case of Expendable Supplies, said single contract must be at least twenty five (25%) of the ABC for this project.
 3. Certificate of PhilGEPS Registration
 4. Latest income and business tax returns per Revenue Regulations 3-2005;
 - a) If the filing of the business and income tax returns is joint as in BIR Form No. 1701, the combined tax returns must be for the period ending December 31, 2022.
 - b) If the filing is not joint as in BIR Form No. 1702, the income tax return must be for the period ending December 31, 2022 and the business tax return must cover the 4th quarter of 2022 or December 31, 2022.
 5. Latest Tax Clearance

Class “B” Documents

1. If applicable, the Joint Venture Agreement (JVA) in case it is already in existence, or duly notarized statements from all the potential joint venture partners stating that they will enter into and abide by the provisions of the JVA in the instance that the bid is successful.
2. Sworn Statement by the prospective bidder or its duly authorized representative in the form prescribed by the GPPB as to the following:

- a.) It is not “blacklisted” or barred from bidding by the GOP or any of its agencies, offices, corporations or LGUs, including foreign government/foreign or international financing institution whose blacklisting rules have been recognized by the GPPB;
- b.) Sworn affidavit of the bidder that it is not related to the HOPE, members of the BAC, the TWG, BAC Secretariat, the head of the Project Management Office or end-user unit by consanguinity or affinity up to the third civil degree.
