

BAC Resolution No. 0444, Series of 2025**Procurement of food and accommodation for the Gender and Development Focal Point System (GAD-FPS) Proposal Writing**

WHEREAS, the Department of Agriculture has a Purchase Request for the Procurement of food and accommodation for the Gender and Development Focal Point System (GAD-FPS) Proposal Writing with an Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) of Seventy-Five Thousand Pesos Only (Php 75,000.00).

WHEREAS, upon careful evaluation, validation, and verification of all the documentary requirements and specification stated in the Request for Quotation, **MO2 WESTOWN HOTEL** is considered as the lowest offeror and with price quotation within the ABC and it was found to be compliant with the eligibility requirements as evidenced by the submission of its 2025 Mayor's/Business Permit and provision of PhilGEPS Registration Number.
